Supplementary regulations for open event (RTV, CCV/Open) to be held on

Sunday ____/____/ 2010.

1. ORGANISING EVENT. The event will be held by Torbay 4x4 Club.
2. EVENT DETAILS. The event will be an Open Trial, to incorporate RTV, CCV/Open trial, to be held on Sunday ____/____/2010 at _____.
3. DECLARATION. Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sport Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these supplementary regulations.
4. GENERAL REGULATIONS. Only competing vehicles are to leave the car parking area and proceed to the trials sections (with the exception of the official safety vehicle). Only signed on drivers, passengers and marshals will be allowed in any of the competing vehicles and must be in a properly fitted seat with approved seat belt. Seat belts must be worn at all times, even when travelling between sections. A 5mph speed limit applies to the whole site, and must be adhered to at all times. Any person who does not comply with these regulations will be asked to leave the site.
5. DRIVER AND PASSENGER ELIGIBILITY. All drivers must produce a valid club membership card. All passengers shall be properly seated, the seat backs shall be upright and the seat adequately fixed. All occupants must wear approved seat belts at all times. During the sections only one passenger seated in forward facing seats will be allowed, the seat back shall be upright and the passenger shall face forward. The passenger sitting alongside the driver must be at least 14 years of age. Drivers must hold a valid full licence (not provisional).
6. SCRUTINEERING. Scrutineering shall take place at the event starting from 9.00am.
7. START TIME. The event shall start at 10.00am.
8. DESCRIPTION OF EVENT. The event will be an Open Trial, to incorporate RTV, and CCV/Open trials together. There will be eight sections laid out, starting at gate 10 in descending order to gate 1, some of which will be made up of two parts to facilitate each category. Gates 10-4 for the RTV and gates 10-1 for the CCV/Open.
 - 8.1. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY. All vehicles must attend Scrutineering on the day of the event and must also comply with the following: handbrake must hold on 45 degree angle.

Vehicles must be fitted with towing points both front & rear (standard round eyelets are not acceptable on the front of vehicles); a throttle return spring must be fitted. Seat belts and harness must be correctly fitted and sufficiently strong tow ropes must be fitted to the vehicles. Entries will be accepted from vehicles that do not have a current VED licence or Valid MOT certificated, provided they follow the technical regulations as laid out in the MSA 2010 yearbook (blue book).

8.2. CLASS OF VEHICLES AND DESCRIPTION.

8.3. CCV/OPEN VEHICLES (INCORPORATING CCV AND OPEN CLASS). CCV trials and specially laid out with experienced trialers in mind and roll bars and other safety equipment are mandatory. Two classes are permitted.

Class 1- Unlimited Modifications

Class 2- Limited Modifications.

Refer to MSA regulations (blue book 2010) for full details.

Open class allows novice drivers and vehicles which do not comply with RTV sections. This will allow older or non-road worthy vehicles to be used. These classes are permitted:

Class 3- Wheelbase less than 85''

Class 4- Wheelbase 85'' to 96''

Class 5- Wheelbase greater than 96''

Permitted and required vehicle modifications are detailed in the MSA regulations (blue book 2010).

9. VEHICLE STARTING POSITIONS. Vehicle starting position will be announced prior start of the event, no numbers will be placed on vehicles, however, numbers will be announced at signing-on. After each section the vehicle to start will alter by moving forward two to three places (this will be announced at the drivers meeting prior to the event start).

10. NUMBER OF COMPETITORS. The minimum number of entries will be 10 and the maximum 50.
11. TIMING OF ENTRIES. Entries will only be accepted at the event itself, by application to the Secretary of the meeting between 9.00am-9.45am.
12. ENTRY FEES AND REFUNDS. The entry fee for the event shall be set at £20.00, payable at the time of the application. No refunds shall be given.
